

Contemporary Music Director/Worship Leader

Part-Time, 15 hours per week.

Estimated Hours Needed:

- 2 planning, preparing music
- 1 Scheduling/Contacts
- 3 Mid-week rehearsal
- 3 Sunday rehearsal/Worship leadership
- 1-2 Worship Planning/Staff coordinating meeting
- 1-2 Helping Coordinate C+
- 1-2 Personal practice
- 1-2 Recruitment, Community building, etc.

The Director of Contemporary Worship/Worship Leader will be responsible coordinating and planning the contemporary worship service (11:00), and leading the worship music/musicians each week.

Supervises contemporary Audio/Visual team

Core Competencies and Experience:

Music

- Degree in music or equivalent training & expertise
- Expertise playing, singing, and leading a band (particularly in worship setting)
- Have a working knowledge of musical styles of different instruments (guitar, keyboards, bass, drums) to be able to coach musicians
- Develop current musicians and their skillsets
- Discover, invite, and equip new musicians
- Expertise leading music vocally and instrumentally
- Expertise in leading congregation in song
- Display knowledge and proficiency in current contemporary music repertoire, as well as a passion to discover and incorporate new music

Worship Planning

- Have a working knowledge of Liturgical Lutheran Worship and how to re-tradition for a contemporary worship experience
- Comfortable and skilled in public speaking during worship, leading prayers, etc.
- Create and coordinate a schedule of musicians for contemporary worship.
- Be able to work with pastors/staff to creatively curate a meaningful worship experience
- Proficiency in technological tools (Audio Technology, Songselect, Mediashout, Planning Center Online, etc.)

- Engage creative gifts of the congregation to enhance worship through other artistic modes (visual, writing, etc.)

Community & Ministry

- A committed Christian who can support the mission of God through Good Shepherd Lutheran Church to *Follow Christ, Grow in Faith, and Share God's Love* and be a partner in ministry with current staff.
- Foster and cultivate a sense of community among contemporary worship musicians and audio/visual teams.
- Invite new musicians, A/V people, and creatives to be a part of contemporary worship leadership.

- Weekly musical worship leadership for 11 worship
- Planning and leading mid-week rehearsals
- Develop and train musicians
- Work with Audio/Visual volunteers to ensure quality and consistency
- Work with other volunteers to rehearse, teach, and lead C+ (High School Worship Band)
