<u>7:13 Team Learning:</u>: Lanny Schnipper presented a summary of the third chapter of The Nones, The Demographics of Disaffiliation.

<u>7:28 Approval of Agenda</u>: A motion to approve the agenda was made by Sharon Misuraca and seconded by Greg Mueller. Approval of the motion passed unanimously.

<u>7:27 Consent Agenda:</u> With one change to the Council Minutes from 2/2024, the motion to accept the consent agenda was made by Ed Seuc and seconded by Lanny Schnipper. The motion passed unanimously.

<u>7:35 Strategic Planning – Developing Measures for the Plan:</u> lead by Ed Seuc. Develop measures for Children/Youth and family, Belonging. Leadership development.

**Service Goals**: Continue to build team planning for congregational engagement with LifeWise:100 unique individuals participate in 2024. Of them, 90% participants would engage again. (We will be deleting the goal: Increase the members who know what LifeWise is, which has been met.)

### **Belonging Goals:**

Discussed the Belonging plan for church physical safety and security - develop a roadmap for safety and security for all who attend. Need to have a plan for weekday, weeknight, and weekend. Forecast expenses to achieve this goal. The team will continue to further develop this effort and will create a plan by the end of August.

<u>Donation Policy</u> (regarding when it should come to Council), presented by Jill Thompson. Elements of a needed Donation Policy were discussed and will be refined and voted on at the next Council Meeting.

A motion to accept a donation to refurbish the choir room, pending FMPC approval, and which did not come from a church appeal, was made by Marcus Raymond, and seconded by Greg Mueller. The motion was passed by majority.
